Update from Father Weslin

We are trying something new this month. With the cost of printing and postage being so high, we at the Mary Weslin Homes decided to reduce our monthly newsletter to one page while still conveying the essential information to you about what is happening at the Home. In addition to sending the monthly status report to you as a “family member” who has contributed in the past, I will continue to include some philosophy and theology about what is happening on the national level.

We found it necessary to reduce our expenses to only the essentials. Mailing a monthly newsletter is so expensive that the normal monthly income does not allow for the cost of the mailing. We are trying to be frugal. We rely solely on the responses to our newsletter and depend on Divine Providence to stay afloat. Mother Teresa did that – and they sent her Rolls Royces! But she is Mother Teresa – and she's in heaven!

That's a good idea! Pray to Mother Teresa for us! I spent a beautiful 9-month learning experience working the streets for her in the Bronx and lower New York City. Pray to her for us.

Things are going well at the Home. Even though our young pregnant resident moved out, we are anticipating that new mothers will move in soon. It is good to have more than one mother. Some nights, at the Home, the Moms will stay up until the wee hours discussing their future, school, house rules, why the Housemother put the sign up on the refrigerator that says: “RULE # One: The Housemother is always right! Rule # Two: If you think the Housemother is wrong, check Rule # One!”

My legal situation will be clearer on November 1st, All Saints Day (I was arrested under the FACE Act for entering the abortion clinic in Bellevue, NE.) Please pray that the results of the trial are pleasing to Christ. I was cautioned by our defense attorneys not to talk about the case until it is over. So I'll brief you after the trial is over. I am trying to do as Jesus did. He was arrested, tortured, dragged out of the city walls where they killed Him. He never fought back. Neither will I. All of the Apostles were imprisoned as well.

At the Mary Weslin Homes we hide the Moms out with their babies who are yet to be born. We hide them out from satan until they are born and then (hopefully) protected by the law.

God Bless You all. To Jesus, through Mary, Our Mother and Our 12-Star General.
